September 11, 2011 marks the 10th anniversary of the worst terrorist attack on American soil. Nearly 3,000 victims died in the attacks. Among the 2,753 victims who died in the attacks on the World Trade Center were 343 firefighters and 60 police officers from New York City and the Port Authority, and 8 private emergency medical technicians and paramedics. Another 184 people were killed in the attack on the Pentagon. The overwhelming majority of casualties were civilians. RECIPE OF THE MONTH

SLOW COOKER SHREDDED PORK

You can use this versatile recipe for sandwiches, tacos, stuffed baked potatoes or on a plate with sweet potatoes, apples or other vegetables for a delicious Fall meal.

|--|------------------------------|
| 1 (15-oz) can tomato sauce | Kosher salt |
| 3T chili powder | Freshly cracked black pepper |
| 3T light brown sugar | 5 cloves garlic, minced |
| 2 t. ground coriander | 2 yellow onions, diced |
| 1 t. ground cumin | 1/4 cup fresh lime juice |
| 1 (3-lb) pork shoulder (or butt),
trimmed of excess fat | |

Directions

Combine the tomato sauce, chili powder, brown sugar, coriander and cumin in your slow cooker. Stir to combine and distribute the spices evenly.

Sprinkle the pork with salt and pepper and place it in the slow cooker. Turn the pork to coat it evenly in the sauce. Add in the garlic and onions, stir again. Place the lid on the slow cooker and cook until the pork is tender and beginning to fall apart, on low 8 to 10 hours or on high 4 to 6 hours. Transfer the pork to a serving bowl. Allow to cool slightly, and then shred using 2 forks, removing any excess fat.

Skim any excess fat off of the sauce remaining in the slow cooker. Stir in the lime juice and season with salt and pepper. Add the shredded pork back into the slow cooker and mix it with the sauce that was created during the cooking. Serves 8.
