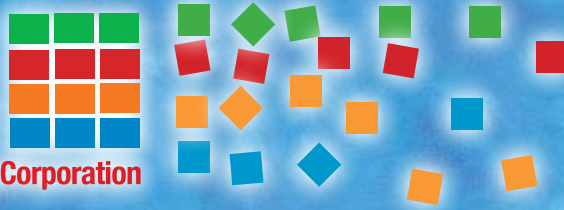

Statement of Non-Discrimination

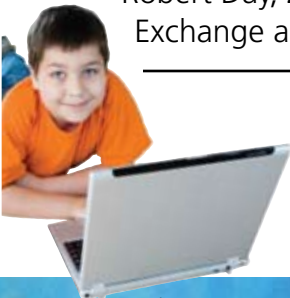

Bacon & Tomato Pasta

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

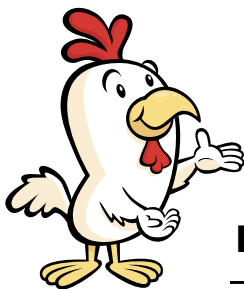
This is easy and delicious. Add hot rolls and a salad and you'll think you're at your favorite Italian restaurant.

- 2 tablespoons kosher salt
- 16 ounces spaghetti noodles
- 1 pound thick-cut bacon chopped
- 3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 cup red onion, diced
- 1 teaspoon red chili flakes

- 3 tablespoons garlic, minced
- 2 cups Roma tomatoes, diced
- 1/4 cup red wine
- 4 tablespoons chopped fresh basil
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper

In a large stock pot, bring water to a rolling boil. Add 2 tablespoons kosher salt and the pasta and cook according to package directions. In a large fry pan over medium heat, add bacon and saute until bacon is crispy. Remove bacon to drain on a paper towel-lined plate and remove 3/4 of the bacon fat from the pan. Add extra-virgin olive oil, onions, and red chili flakes. Cook until onions are translucent, add garlic, cook for 2 minutes then add tomatoes. Saute for 5 minutes, then deglaze with wine. (For safety and to prevent flare ups, remove pan from heat while you deglaze) return pan to heat. Drain pasta and add to the tomato mixture pan. Add basil and bacon. Toss with Parmesan cheese, add salt and pepper to taste. Serve immediately.
